Ben Richard From buying and selling on-job listings and services, Craigslist is an online community to which you can also place free ads. A simple format, location search and an anonymous filter to hide your email address also make Craigslist easy and secure to use. Whether you're selling an overgrown bike or advertising upcoming sales tags or posting vacancies, Craigslist makes it easy to hand over your old merchandise and find recruiting candidates. Browse Craigslist (full link to resources) and click on a post for ads called Craigslist. Also, log in and then click on the Mail button for ads. Choose the type of posting and click Continue. Include the name and location, if applicable. Use email in each box next to Answer: and choose whether to show, hide or anonymize your email. Review your email carefully to confirm that it is correct so that customers can respond to your post. Check the box below if it is good for others to contact you about other services. Click Change text if you see anything to change as part of the preview. When you're done, click Continue. Check the email you used to post the ad. Use a link in a message from robot@craigslist.org to confirm your post. Keep this message until your ad is deleted or expires, or bookmark a link in your browser. Click accept after reading the terms of use and your ads on Craigslist. Designed by Mary Schafraht.Craigslist is the best. But, also the worst. You fall in love with a big chair, go all the way to someone else's house in a remote area, and it's gone, or totally not as advertised. Well, never again. Some people have an innate knack for hunting. Nadia Spiegelman, the savvy web surfer behind the Craigslist curator gave us a scoop on pulling off a successful deal - minus the jerkiness. (Plus, we've added a few tricks of our own.) Read on and what vintage Schwinn, Ames rocker, and Victorian sofa are over for the taking. No salesman wants to read a long, drawn-out novel about how amazed you are with their vintage, red-lacquered dresser. They are trying to sell it quickly and not a creepy person. The best answer is always quick. Nadia uses this template: Hi, there, I like your ... and I'd like to buy it from you. Please let me know a convenient time to come pick it up. Be sure to mention a specific item so the owner knows you are not a spammer. Once you have made contact, you can put all your additional questions (price bargaining, sizes, etc.) in the next letter. Also, always let the seller know if you can pay in cash. They'll be much more willing to see you. Design Shafraht. On a serious hunt? The quickest way to search is through a miniature gallery site where tiny photos are paired with text blurbs. Maybe everyone always knew about it - but when I discovered it, it blew my mind, says Nadia. Sellers often don't mark lists correctly. If looking for a dining table, be sure to check under antiques and furniture. Putting your item in quotes in a search bar can increase your luck, too. Designed by Mary Schafraht.Safety is primarily the motto of the mission. Nadia recommends always bringing a friend, even if you feel good vibrations. Go to someone else's house after dark is not strictly worth it. And, two sets of eyes are better than one for taking a close look at what you're going to buy... As for bed bugs, she says you can't live in fear. When I go to pick up furniture, I sometimes ask the seller face to face if they've ever had bed bugs - then you just have to trust your instincts. If the image on the post is not the best quality, ask for photos taken from different angles before you waste someone's time seeing the piece in person. Most items are posted on the weekend, as this is when people actually have time to deal with their mess. Use the mouse on hand on Friday night. And when the seller lists the phone number, always call before the email. If you don't have a car, finding lists in your immediate area is a good idea. A man-with-van service can be expensive, and carrying items in the subway is a huge pain, she says. Designed by Mary Schafraht.Always remember that you don't have to buy anything. Sometimes you arrive at the seller's house and the goods will not look like photos. When you're in someone's house and judging their stuff, things can get personal pretty quickly, she says. The key is to keep the waiver simple. I usually say: It's fine, but the color is different from the photo and won't fit the rest of my furniture. It's that simple. Craigslist allows users to buy and sell products or place ads for those in the community to read or share. The service was launched in the mid-1990s and has since spread across continents. But what is Craigslist, and how does it work? In 1995, San Francisco resident Craig Newmark created an online center designed to inform visitors about local events. Soon, people started using Craig's small platform to accommodate jobs, services, items for sale, and more, eventually requiring the use of a server. At a time of housing shortage in San Francisco, people began to place ads for rental apartments in the city and its neighborhood. In response, Craig wrote a software that can automatically add emails to the website: craigslist.org. Finally, in 1999, Craig was able to devote himself to a full-time Craigslist. Craigslist functions as an online ad forum, but it also allows for community discussion, job openings, advertising services, and more. Visitors can place their own ads, apply for concerts, or take advantage of the deals they are interested in. Craigslist shows many sections. Some of the key sections you'll find include: Community: This section for events and trends taking place in your community, including classes, lost and found items, political and local news. There's also a unique section called Rants and Raves where posters can share any thoughts and feelings they have. Services: Here's where you'll find people and organizations offering services such as car repair, website design, or dog walk. Hull: Use this section to find or advertise apartments for rent. You can also find real estate listings in your area, whether you want to buy, sell, rent or trade. Jobs: Jobs are very common on Craigslist. You can find listings for almost any area, including education, real estate, accounting, security and Media.For Sale: If you're looking for an item on the cheap, this is where you'll find it. One of the most commonly used areas of Craigslist, these ads are placed by individuals selling anything from furniture to collectible figurines. Discussion Forums: Craigslist has forums to discuss almost everything under the sun such as technological products, religion, celebrities and politics. You can use the Wanted category in the For Sale section to request specific items you might want, or to view other people's query lists. Craig Newmark was once asked to include sponsored ads on his website, but declined the offer. Instead, Craigslist focuses on only a couple of revenue streams, including: Job fees: There's a fee for placing vacancies in major U.S. cities, and it ranges from \$7 to \$75, depending on location. Apartment accommodation fee: Persons who advertise apartments in Boston, Chicago and New York are charged \$5 per accommodation. Other accommodation fees: Craigslist also charges for other posts, mainly depending on the region. You can find the full list on the Craigslist posting fees page. Follow these instructions to set up and start using Craigslist Marketplace. You can follow these exactly the same steps to find other messages such as concerts, accommodation and more. Go to craigslist to craigsling. If you have a location service, Craigslist will pull the largest community homepage closest to your neighborhood. Use the search bar on the left to manually search for ads or view subcategories in the Sale section. Each listing is different, with different levels of detail. Each ad will have a map of the common location for the item, as well as a description. You can learn about the item by selecting the Answer in the top left corner of the page. You will be given the opportunity to reply directly by email or use the email provider of your choice. Craigslist allows posters to mask your email address to keep their personal information secret. The email you see and use will be directed to the poster's email account in the file. You can use voice search to find service or concert on Craigslist. Through Siri, Alexa, or Google Assistant, tell Craigslist next to me to be sent to your regional Craigslist page. You can also use voice commands to find items or services. For example, you can ask to see puppies on Craigslist to see see cities and their lists of puppies. You can use Craigslist forums to participate in or start conversations about almost anything, from classical music to the latest iPhone. In this section you can choose a forum to view using the search bar at the top of the page. Once you've selected a forum, you'll see a list of all the topics and discussions related to a particular topic or search term. If you see something that interests you, choose blue hyperlink areas to see the answer in more detail. To respond to a message in the forum, you will need to register for a Craigslist account. You can create a new thread to start a new discussion or comment on others by replying. You can also evaluate a person's response or tag it if it is inappropriate. Forums are a great place to learn, discuss topics, and make friends. Just like any other online activity, it's important to stay safe. If you're selling a product, service, or hosting a gig on Craigslist, here are some safety tips to keep in mind: Don't add all your contact information: Keep your contact information to a minimum, just enough for buyers or those interested in your post to reach out. Accept cash only for cash transactions: Not when accepting checks or money transfers for your product or service. Many scams have occurred for buyers using these methods. Always invite customers to a safe place: if you don't have a place to go for business and you're a selling person, meet the buyer in a public place. Never invite buyers to your home. For shoppers on Craigslist, it's best always: Ask questions: If you're not sure about the item or service you're interested in, be sure to ask questions. You can also request more photos, past transactional information and other details. Don't send money first: Never send money to the seller before viewing the item or knowing exactly what you're buying. This is a good way to get scammed.
